Core Responsibilities:

- As the Head of Department, you will be responsible for leading and managing the Department of Communication Design, ensuring high standards in teaching, research, and professional practice.
- As a full-time faculty member, you are expected to teach studio and theory courses relevant to your skill set, mentor students, contribute actively to curriculum development in the department and to institutional activities, and actively pursue opportunities for research, publication, and scholarly/creative practice.

Qualifications:

Master's degree in Textile, design, or a related field, and prior teaching and professional experience.

Candidates with experience in a leadership position will be preferred.

Required Skills:

- Effective management skills to oversee department operations, including resource allocation and strategic planning.
- Ability to develop the curriculum and review courses to ensure high educational standards.
- An interdisciplinary approach to design teaching and learning.
- Strong leadership and problem-solving skills, including a willingness to be a team player and mentor.
